Up to 4 guests can be accommodated in each comfortable cottage or a party of 8 can use the two as integral accommodation.

Each cottage has two reception rooms and well-fitted kitchens.

- Site of the Battle of Winceby

- Golf courses at Woodhall Spa, West Ashby, Boston and Skegness.
